

Did You Know? (Tweets of Torah)

Parashat Bo tells the story of the Exodus from Egypt after two centuries of Jewish exile and enslavement. We read that, when the Israelites left, they took with them the utensils and clothing of their Egyptian neighbors, as G-d had commanded (Ex. 12:35). Our sages tell us that this clothing was worn throughout the 40 years of travel in the wilderness, the garments remaining miraculously intact and fresh.

Why was it appropriate for the Israelites to wear these garments? Why would G-d want them to wear the belongings of the debased, idolatrous Egyptian society - at Sinai?

The Chatam Sofer (R" Moshe Sofer, 1762-1839) explains that something significant happened to these garments on the night of the Exodus. Besides killing the firstborn of Egypt, G-d also destroyed the country's idols, fulfilling His promise to "... make judgment upon all the pagan gods of Egypt" (12:12). He also removed all idolatrous images from the objects upon which they were engraved, including those embroidered onto the Egyptians' clothing. By the time the Israelites took the garments, they had undergone a miraculous change, and no longer bore images of pagan gods.
